We will not be starting formal PE sessions until the children are fully settled. I will inform you when this will be. Forest school will take place on Wednesday mornings. Children will need a named pair of wellies to be kept at school. They will also need to bring in a change of clothes that are weather appropriate in a named bag that they will change into for forest school.
