Mrs Pell will be our Forest School teacher on Thursday afternoons supported by Miss Villalba.</p> <p><u>Reading and Home Learning</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Please listen to your child read their Little Wandle school reading book or free-reader book at least 3 times a week. • Little Wandle School Reading book will be changed every Friday. • Year 2 children will have access to TTRS for times tables practise. • Year 1 children will have maths activity cards (changed every Friday) • Reading for pleasure book changed every Thursday during library time. <p><u>PE and Forest School</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • PE will be on a Tuesday and Wednesday. PE kit should include: black shorts/jogging bottoms/leggings, white t-shirt, school jumper and trainers. Earrings must be removed before coming to school on PE days. <i>I recommend your child’s PE kit stays at school and we will ensure it is sent home half termly.</i> • Forest School will be on Thursday afternoons. Please ensure your child has their Forest School kit at school on the Thursday of Forest School. Forest School kit should include: Long sleeve top, long trousers, trainers or wellies, a sun hat in warm weather, woolly hat and gloves in cold weather. <p><u>What we need in school every day</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Named book bag with reading book and reading record. <u>It is essential that these are in school every day.</u> • Named water bottle containing water only please. • A named pair of wellies to be left at school. • PE kit with trainers, in a named bag, to be left at school. • Long hair must be tied back. • A named bottle of sun cream (to be left at school) and sunhat. <p><u>What to do if you have any concerns</u></p> <p>I can be contacted at any time via the school office email address office@sutton.norfolk.sch.uk or appointments can be arranged for after school.</p>
